

# AARON SALANT, 89, EX-APPAREL MAKER

Aaron B. Salant, former chairman and president of Salant & Salant, Inc., apparel manufacturers at 330 Fifth Avenue, died Friday at his apartment in the Volney Hotel. His age was 89.

Mr. Salant was president of the company from 1936 to 1946 and chairman from then until his retirement two years ago. He was a member of the New York bar, but had not practiced law.

He was graduated in 1897 from City College as valedictorian of his class and the winner of some 15 prizes for scholarship. Mr. Salant then taught in the public schools, and in 1901 joined a predecessor of Salant & Salant.

Surviving are a son, Walter S. Salant, economist of the Brookings Institution; a daughter, Mrs. Marie S. Neuberger; a sister, Mrs. Harriet S. Winter; eight grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren.

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
